The sold out #PartyIntheStacks took place on Saturday, October 19, 2019 at the iconic Toronto Reference Library where over 800 attendees embraced the event's theme 'Possibilities Revealed'; exploring activations throughout the space and discovering impressive new things about the world's busiest public library system.

The popular spot of the night was Lead Sponsor RBC InvestEase's Photo Booth located in the center of all the action on the atrium's main stage. Guests could capture an animated party moment and immediately upload it to their social media. Toronto-based creative agency, Array of Stars (AOS) was the event's Artistic Director that produced a customized installation that combined motion-tracking technology and LED walls, bringing a user-augmented experience to life at the Library. In addition, guests could explore first-hand several unexpected programs and services regularly offered at Toronto Public Library, like Virtual Reality, 3-D printing and Dial-a-Story.
